It has been referred to the Committee for further discussion before decisions are made at a future General Meeting.

The General Meetings have continued to have a number of birds on display. This has generated good discussions and a healthy evaluation of the birds. Don't forget that **Table Shows** have been split into Beginner and Open sections, with the best Any Age, Young Bird and Nestfeather in each section receiving a \$5.00 voucher from the Club. That's \$30 in prize money every meeting night! Isn't it time you joined in and made these Table Shows even bigger and more interesting. Next month **Ian Schneider** is discussing how to have a small but successful stud of birds. There will also be a power-point display of what to look for in an exhibition budgerigar. Try not to miss this one.

The **Young Bird Show** is the next big show on our calendar. It doubles as the selection for our team to compete in the Zone Selection Show in Townsville. Birds selected there will travel to Tasmania and the national Championships. The schedule for our Young Bird Show is enclosed with this newsletter. Special Conditions of Show.

1. All Young Birds entered in Young Bird classes must be available for selection in the CBS Inc. team to contest the Zone Championship Show for selection in the Nth. & C.Q. Zone Team for this year's ANBC C'ships .
2. The first 3 placings are automatic selections.

Major trophies & variety trophies as listed in this schedule are for Young Bird classes only.

All persons responsible for winning exhibits must be present at the completion of judging for checking of rings, otherwise exhibits will be disqualified.

Club rules must be strictly adhered to.

Drinkers must be in show cages & cage stickers adhered on the RIGHT hand side of show cage

Exhibitors are reminded that the responsibility of having birds entered in the correct class is their own.

The hens class will be judged first, with the first three hens being awarded those positions. The remainder of the hens will be re-judged in their respective colour classes. The owners of the second and third placed hens have the option of returning these respective birds to their colour class at the conclusion of the judging of the hen's class. Their decision at this time is final.

All birds entered must be owner bred with birds in Young Bird classes being 2008 rung.

Dear Member

Following the great success of the 2008 Winter Auction, our Club is again conducting a major Auction on the Queen's Birthday weekend (June 7). Birds from top southern breeders and exhibitors as well as from local Zone fanciers will be assembled. It is anticipated that many fanciers from Cairns to the Gold Coast will be attending, as well as several well known inter-state exhibitors. The venue for this year's auction is the Performing Arts Centre, North R'ton High School, Simpson Street, North Rockhampton. Off-street parking from Simpson Street is available.

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to submit birds for benching at this event. It is expected that birds offered will be no more than 2 years of age (rung 2007/8), and that freighting to and from Rockhampton will be organised and paid for by you. However, care of the birds, show cages, benching, etc will be fully organised by the Capricornia Budgerigar Society Inc. (CBS Inc.). The CBS Inc. will retain a 10% commission on the selling price. An entry fee of \$1 per bird also applies.

As part of our advertising we wish to place a catalogue on our club web site to generate interest. It would be appreciated if you could **provide details on the attached proforma and return this to me by April 17**. This should ensure that the catalogue reaches cyberspace and can be posted to the fanciers in many Queensland Clubs by the end of April. A photo of a nominated bird or birds can be included for possible use in the catalogue.

It would be appreciated if you could advise me as soon as possible if you are able to provide **up to eight birds**. If you are unable to supply birds then these can be re-allocated as we are limiting the lots to approx 200 to 240 and the demand for lots in this event is strong.

We have also organised a 'Pre-Auction' Meal and 'get-together' on the Saturday evening. This has been well patronised in previous years. It is an enjoyable function and a great opportunity to have a good feed and a great chat to many of the top local and visiting breeders. It's a chance to learn a few trade secrets as well as get some inside information from the breeders of some of the birds being auctioned the next day.

Thank you for your consideration and support. I look forward to your reply and a profitable and successful auction.
