This 'Day of Show' entry method will continue for the next 2 shows in 2011 before being reviewed. Perhaps it was a one-off aberration. Congratulations to all who were able to compete and share in the prize money. The results are in this newsletter. A special mention to **Russell and Cheryl Ogden** who achieved Grand Champion of Show at their first show as Open exhibitors. They certainly had the form on the board with previous wins at shows in Bundy, Maryborough and Brisbane. Well done! Well done to Arthur Turnbull and John Agnew on winning the Derby cock and hen respectively and hence sharing the Derby prizemoney (about \$60 each)!

With the Annual Show completed it is now time to focus on the Nationals and all the lead-in shows! The schedule for our **Young Bird Selection Show** (May 14) is included with this newsletter. The top 3 in each class receive a c ash prize and automatic entry to the Zone Show in Townsville. Bring all those 2010 rung birds along. There is also a class for any nestfeathers. These will be 2011 rung.

As advertised in January, the Club is organising an **aviary visit to Brisbane** to coincide with the SQ BRASEA Auction. This is on the weekend of July 16 & 17. We are intending to hire a bus to ensure all of our members are able to attend. To allow for arrangements to be made, members wishing to join us need to contact the secretary or treasurer and pay a **deposit of \$50**. Final costs are not known at this stage, as the need for a bus will be determined by the number of attendees. If fewer people register, then a mini-bus will be booked.

The **Zone Show** will be conducted in Townsville on the weekend of May 21 & 22. This is the most important event in our Zone Calendar. We are looking forward to taking a strong team to represent our Club and hopefully gain representation to the ANBC Show the week after. Our Club covers all costs for the birds participating in the ZONE and ANBC Shows. Go for it.

The **monthly meetings** this year have been of an excellent standard with the focus being on judging the Table Show birds and discussing the many aspects of the hobby and birds. Come and enjoy these meetings.

Our **Annual Auction** is shaping as our best ever with over 200 birds entered. The Catalogue for this event has been forwarded to email addresses that I have. #### **Special Conditions of Show.**

1. All Young Birds entered in Young Bird classes must be available for selection in the CBS Inc. team to contest the Zone Championship Show for selection in the Nth. & C.Q. Zone Team for this year's ANBC Championship Show in Canberra.

2. The first 3 placings are automatic selections.

Major trophies & variety trophies as listed in this schedule are for <u>Young Bird classes only.</u>
All persons responsible for winning exhibits must be present at the completion of judging for checking of rings, otherwise exhibits will be disqualified.

Club rules must be strictly adhered to.

Drinkers must be in show cages & cage stickers adhered on the RIGHT hand side of show cage

Exhibitors are reminded that the responsibility of having birds entered in the correct class is their own.

The hen's class will be judged first, with the first three hens being awarded those positions. The remainder of the hens will be re-judged in their respective colour classes. The owners of the second and third placed hens have the option of returning these respective birds to their colour class at the conclusion of the judging of the hen's class. Their decision at this time is final.

3. All birds entered must be owner bred with birds in Young Bird classes being 2010 rung.
