## **Feather Cysts** By Dennis Beckett.

Unfortunately, most of us have had birds that have developed feather cysts. I had a lovely dark green Cock bird fledge with one already beginning to grow and tried to find a suitable treatment. Sifting through the internet articles, I came across the following treatment.

I purchased a product called Essence of Propolis from the UK. It is described as being “an antibacterial - natural in beehive - from the Gums and resin of our hedgerows and trees.” (Note: make sure the essence cannot reach the eyes) I first dabbed the essence directly onto the cyst. After a couple of days the cyst had began to shrivel up a little and I saw a couple of black spots. I grabbed one of the spots with my finger nails and was surprised to pull out a feather quill about a 2cm long.

Other smaller quills also were pulled out. I then ensured the essence got into the cyst. A few more days and I pulled away a scab and gently squeezed out a lump of waxy type material about the size of my small finger nail. More essence and after about 7 days the cyst was almost totally gone.

We have used it on a couple of other birds with the same results. The Dark Green cock bird never grew a tail, but is filling eggs in the breeding room. The cyst, so far, hasn't regrown. I can't say that it is the answer to feather cysts, but it seems to have worked for me. Better than having the bird not being of any use to you.

(It always seems to be the better birds)



### **Special Conditions of Show**

**All young birds entered in Young Bird classes must be available for selection in the CBS Inc. team to contest the Zone Championship Show.**

**The first 3 placings are automatic selections.**

Major trophies & variety trophies as listed in this schedule are for Young Bird Classes only.

All persons responsible for winning exhibits must be present at the completion of judging for checking of rings otherwise exhibits will be disqualified.

Club rules must be strictly adhered to.

Exhibitors are reminded that the responsibility of having birds entered in the correct class is their own.

The hen's class will be judged first, with the first three hens being awarded those positions. The remainder of the hens will be re-judged in their respective variety classes. The owners of the second and third placed hens have the option of returning these respective birds to their variety class at the conclusion of the hen's class. Their decision at this time is final.

**All birds entered must be owner bred with birds entered in Young bird classes being 2022 rung (Purple Rings)**
