PUTTING A COMPETITIVE BIRD TOGETHER DO YOU KNOW YOUR BIRDS

Talking to some moderately experienced fanciers this year, there were discussions about improving minor varieties – "what am I doing wrong?"

Minor varieties, Recessive Pieds, Clearwings, Fallows, Greywings, all the recessive varieties are very hard to breed to a competitive standard and there are many thoughts on ways 'improve' your birds when you talk to experienced fanciers. The best advice I could give a breeder of a minor variety, well any variety, but especially minor varieties, is that you need to know the characteristics of the strain of birds you have available. Let me expand......

Since the introduction of Imports, the English Budgerigars were generally line bred and every line of birds, both from the English breeders to the Australian breeders lines will behave differently with line characteristics. When these English birds arrived we were told by those that had them and kept them pure, the chicks produced were like peas in a pod, all much the same. Now this pod of peas were then developed by their breeders in many different ways.

Some lines produce smaller chicks as UBCs, some of which have good feather or features, some not. These smaller chicks had the ability to grow and grow and grow as they mature, and it may be the third moult where you see the best they will be.

Some of these will produce bigger chicks as UBCs, generally those who had the old Aussie birds influence still in the line and a smaller number will have feather and feature, but they will not grow any or much bigger than they are as a UBC, no matter how many moults they have. You will need to identify what your strain / line will and can do.

Most Beginners cross lines of birds by putting together birds which are not related, which will mix up the characteristics, which can be a good thing by developing new — maybe desired characteristics, BUT you will need to learn all over again or from the start, which type of birds you have produced. Unfortunately, getting rid of youngsters to early will inhibit your learning ability but space will dictate how many you can keep. Maybe just keep one or two of those smaller birds to see how they develop against the bigger babies which might stop growing. Now to the question of improving a minor variety.

Breed splits, breed splits, breed splits, that is the advice. Once again you will need to know your birds. As a minor variety breeder, do you breed for good variety or do you try to improve the bird? The BIRD, always improve the bird. A judge will tell you, if they can see it is the correct variety the next and most important decision is how a bird is it. Yes, there are a few occasions when the judge will factor in variety in their decisions, however it will be to

split the quality of the birds in question. You need to get your bird into that quality splitting question..... so quality, quality, quality is your first goal in improving your chosen variety.

The use of splits is the best way of improving quality but it must be a split from a Normal bird which has the feature you want to introduce. Do not use a Normal, not strong enough in quality – you will be wasting your time and birds. Don't use just any Normal. I tell beginners, have a plan for every pairing, write it down and see if that plan has worked. Getting quality Normals can be difficult, especially for the established breeder of recessive varieties and in some cases these experienced breeders, who know the characteristics of their lines, will hold out introducing a Normal until they can find the bird with the feature they want to introduce.

For example, I know of a breeder of Clearwings who has not put in a normal bird for generations. We are told and it is true, that breeding Clearwing to Clearwing will only see the size get smaller and smaller, however the breeder of this Clearwing strain knows that their line of birds does not seem to do this and with selection the size can be increased. By putting Clearwing to Clearwing has allowed a focus on cleaning up the wings. Normals will be required soon for extra features but in this line, at the moment size is not reducing.

I also understand there is a Recessive Pied breeder has not introduced a Normal for generations because the pairing of his Recessive Pied to Recessive Pied has resulted in improved quality, not reduced. I'm sure they will need to introduce a Normal to add a new feature at some stage.

These are two rare occurrences but highlights that knowledge about your birds, how they grow and develop, can help you make decisions on how to put that competitive bird together.
