CODE OF CONDUCT

This document is a guide to members of the CBS Inc., which summarises CBS Inc's expectations of its members and guests at Club functions. Guests include our family, friends, and visitors.

The CBS Inc **Code of Conduct** has been developed to ensure a safe, friendly and respectful place for members and our guests to gather in the spirit of cooperation, relaxation, good will, fun and friendly competition.

The CBS Inc **Code of Conduct** differs from rules in that it provides guidance on what is acceptable behaviour. It is by no means a comprehensive guide, and members and our guests should demonstrate appropriately acceptable behaviour, within the context of our society and applicable law, when situations arise that are not referred to below.

CBS Inc Code Of Conduct.

All members and our guests are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that:

- 1. Creates an environment and culture that is reflective of the personal integrity and respect consistent with the wider community where it is expected that we will conduct ourselves with honesty, integrity and good sportsmanship. This same integrity, honesty and good will is expected at all times whether at a Show, Meeting or Club social function.***
- 2. Does not denigrate the CBS Inc in any way, shape or form either in person, through the media or through any form of social media< is free of discrimination or any form of harassing behaviour including personal, sexual, racial, religious or other forms of harassment.***
- 3. Acknowledges the CBS Inc as a family friendly environment and, therefore, refrains from using obscenities and loud boisterous behaviour inappropriate for children and respectable taste.***
- 4. Observes appropriate social etiquette at all times when representing the Club at any event.***
- 5. Understands that the Club's Committee is responsible for instructing members in the performance of their duties at Club events and shows.***
- 6. Is vigilant in reporting real or perceived safety hazards to the Club's Committee.***
- 7. Does not denigrate, talk down to, or verbally abuse any CBS Inc members or guests, and does not create unnecessary strife and divisiveness in the CBS Inc through any manner whatsoever.***

8. Does not misrepresent their position and/or authority within the CBS Inc to others.

9. Adheres to all Club rules currently in force and effect.

Grievance and Resolution Policy

If a CBS Inc member has a grievance with a fellow CBS Inc member, then the Grievance and Resolution process outlined in the CBS Rules must be strictly adhered to.

Disciplinary Policy

All CBS Inc members will make themselves familiar with the Disciplinary guidelines currently in force and effect.

The inappropriate behaviour of any CBS Inc member will be investigated, discussed and an appropriate course of action will be taken by the Committee, which may include reprimand, suspension or revocation of membership in accordance with CBS Inc Rules of Association:

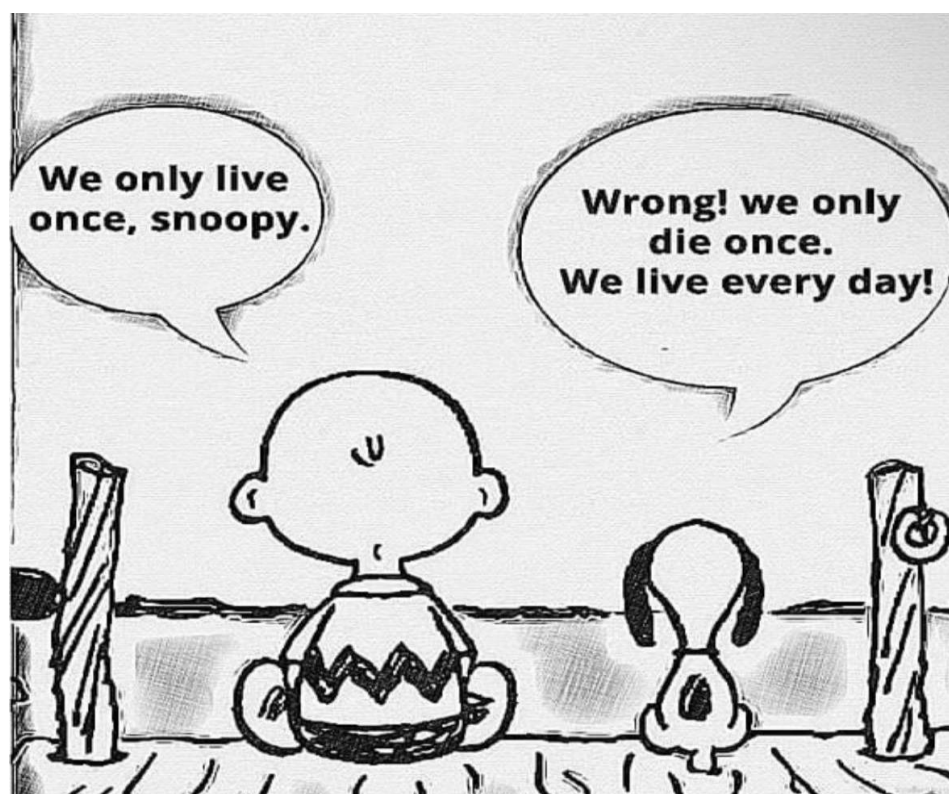

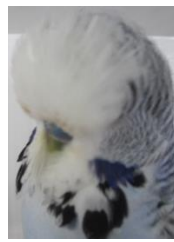

Cages :- Drinkers must be in show cages. Floor covering to be a standard seed mix. Stickers to be adhered to right side of cage.

Special Conditions of Show

All young birds entered in Young Bird classes must be available for selection in the CBS Inc. team to contest the Zone Championship Show in MACKAY.
The first 3 placings are automatic selections. All birds must be owner bred, with birds in Young Bird classes being **2024 rung (Red Rings)**.

Major trophies & variety trophies as listed in this schedule are for Young Bird Classes only.

All persons responsible for winning exhibits must be present at the completion of judging for checking of rings otherwise exhibits will be disqualified.

Club rules must be strictly adhered to.

Exhibitors are responsible for having birds entered in the correct class.

Order of Judging: All hens (including Class 27) will be judged in their respective variety classes. At the end of the show the highest placed hen from each class will be staged and judged to select the best hen. This bird will then be judged against the best cock to select Grand Champion & Opp Sex Bird of Show. At this time the hen's owner will be given a choice as to which class they wish to have their bird entered in for the Zone Selection Show. The remaining hens will be judged and ranked in order. Following this order, each hen can be returned to their Variety class or allocated to the Hen's class (at Owner's request) until 3 birds fill the Hen's class. Variety classes where hens are re-allocated will promote lower placed birds to fill 3 places. Prize money is presented according to these final class positions, including the Hens class. Judges' decision is final.
